- 4 Place items in front of or behind your property between 8 AM and 9 AM on collection day

## Bulk Trash Collection

### How To Prep Bulk Trash

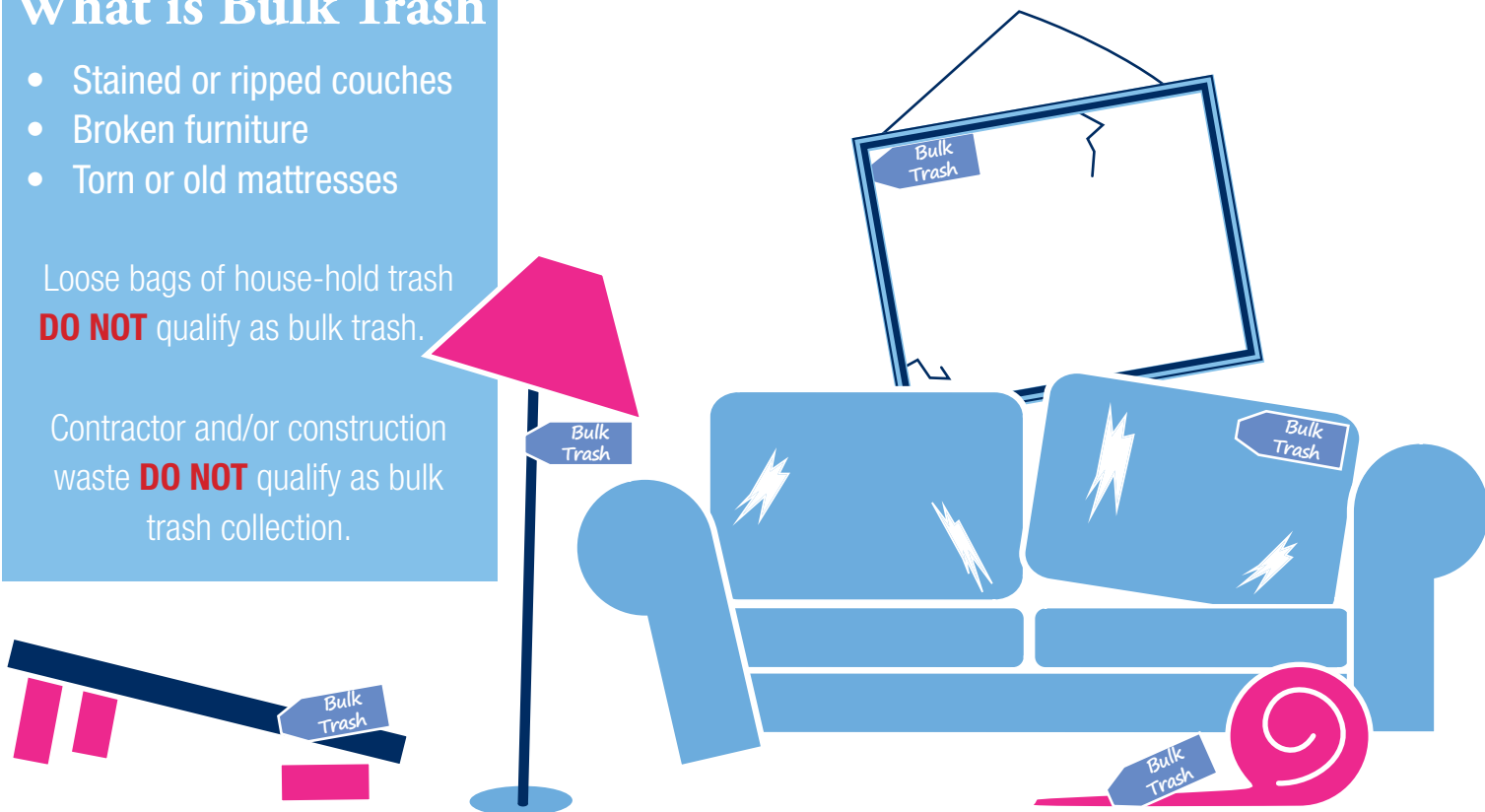
- 1 Sign up for a May bulk trash pick-up day & time at [tinyurl.com/SpringPickUp](https://tinyurl.com/SpringPickUp)
- 2 Pick up **BLUE BULK TRASH TAGS** from the Office of Neighborhood Life, 1300 36th Street
- 3 Place **BLUE BULK TRASH TAGS** on all bulk trash items
- 4 Place items in front of or behind your property between 8 AM and 9 AM on collection day

#### What is Bulk Trash

- Stained or ripped couches
- Broken furniture
- Torn or old mattresses

Loose bags of house-hold trash  
**DO NOT** qualify as bulk trash.

Contractor and/or construction  
waste **DO NOT** qualify as bulk  
trash collection.
